ALTA Member Education Fund

The Fund was created to assist ALTA members who wish to enhance their oil and gas knowledge through college attendance, training programs for the land analyst, CPLTA Review and Certification and/or various courses and seminars offered at various venues. ALTA Scholarship Fund

The student must have a grade point average of no less than 2.5 on a 4.0 grading scale at the time of application.
